#### **Ash Wednesday**

Ash Wednesday is on Wednesday 6 March. This is the beginning of Lent.

The liturgical timetable for the Parish is 7:30am Mass with distribution of ashes **9:15am** Communion Service with ashes 10am College Mass in hall, with ashes 7:30pm Yet to be confirmed.

Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting (two small meals, one main meal, no snacks) for those 18 to 60 years of age and abstinence (from eating meat) for those over 14 years of age.
