2nd Lenten Reflection Morning


'The Call to Holiness in Today's World' Friday 22 March 10 - 11:30am

Social Justice

Youth Unemployment Grows How can we fix this?

The Brotherhood of St Laurence yesterday said that despite almost three decades of economic growth, the youth unemployment rate is stagnating at the levels seen in the early 2000s.

This anti-poverty group said about one-in-nine people aged 15-to-24 are unable to find work – almost triple the rate for those aged 25 and over.

At 11.2% the youth unemployment rate, for those aged 15 to 24 in the labour force, is still more than twice Australia's overall unemployment rate (5%).
