Mataram Road

The road to the north of the church (which is part of Mataram Rd) is almost completed. When it is opened, access to the upper (primary) carpark will be from Mary Mackillop Drive—take the second exit on the roundabout and the eastern side of the GP Clinic and turn left at Mataram Rd. Access to the main carpark will be from Tennyson Woods Close—take the first exit on the roundabout and the western side of the Clinic. The short piece of road next to the church will be closed with bollards most of the time. This is to stop it becoming a "short cut" to the new development and hopefully to provide some land in the future for parish offices or meeting rooms.
