
Response:

This Sunday 2 May, Bishop Anthony will be in the parish to celebrate the sacrament


of confirmation at 12noon 2:30pm. May the children receive the fruits of the Holy Spirit as they are confirmed Christ.

Social Justice World Earth Day

Pope Francis warned a gathering of world leaders and the global community at large for World Earth Day last weekend that "we are at the edge" with climate change, and the time to takeaction is now.

Cali Gurnicki in the U.S, a senior religious studies and theology student at Viterbo University shows us how we can live interconnectedly within creation. She recently discussed putting vegetable skins and left-over fruit scraps and eggshells to use with worm farms. The worms created rich soil for their beloved plants and helped them reduce their food waste.

In adopting this practice Cali gained a deeper level of appreciation for God's creatures and the way we are invited to live interconnectedly within creation, even with the smallest and slimiest of them all.

Each of us can play our part in caring for our common home by reducing waste, lowering our energy consumption, and helping the earth.


