Woman of the Wallaby Track

Mary saw herself clearly as a daughter of Australia and it's heritage. When working as a governess her burning concern for the things of God led her to respond to Christ's invitation to preach good news to the poor and feed the hungry. She contemplated joining the Sisters of Mercy, but she longed for a life of extreme poverty.

Providence brought her to her spiritual guide and friend Fr Tenison Woods. The vision of a catholic school started to emerge. The first building took shape significantly from a stable.

On March 19, 1866 the feast of St Joseph Mary gave an external expression of her desire and intention of becoming a religious. She began to wear a simple black dress with black belt and hat. She felt she was on the road at last.

Do We Unknowingly Use Slave Labour?

During the 2015–16 financial year, 169 alleged human trafficking and slavery offences were referred to the Australian Federal Police.

A new law in Australia requires companies of a certain size operating in Australia to publicly state the steps they are taking to keep their supply chains free from the worst forms of modern-day slavery.

New South Wales passed its own modern slavery law creating an independent anti-slavery commissioner to monitor implementation and promote action against modern slavery. The law creates a range of monetary penalties for companies with employees in New South Wales that fail to comply with the modern slavery statement requirements
