Macquarie Group chief executive Shemara Wikramanayake was paid \$17 million in the past financial year. Mr Moore, will be eligible over the next two years to receive \$81.5 million in performance shares and other incentives that were awarded to him while CEO.

But the Newstart allowance for a single person, is currently worth less than \$270 a week – just \$40 per day.
