Woman of the Wallaby Track

Mary's longing for religious life and the thought of leaving her beloved mother gave her much anxiety. Though she longed for a life of total devotedness to the educational and other needs of the children of Australia, she was ready to do what Fr Woods should decide was best. At his suggestion, in a letter, Mary had started reading Mass prayers and celebrated feast days with the children, due to his long absences. He also wrote that he had mentioned "our great plan" to the Vicar General, to an icy reception. He wrote 'it seems so like a work of God when it meets with opposition and discouragement'. Bishop Sheil liked their idea but after clergy input became sceptical particularly about training and finances. But with the Public Schools Act aiming at secularism in education, catholic teachers and schools was the Church's only answer.
