justice, world poverty, economic  
challenges for families and the prison  
system.

The statements promote a vision of  
God's reign of justice and peace in the  
world. It is a vision of social inclu-  
sion, community and right relation-  
ships. It is a guide to everyone in the  
church community of means to im-  
plementing structures in God's world  
that are fair to all.
