#### Reflection



#### One Woman a Week Killed By A Partner.

Because of this need our group is planning to facilitate skilled workers to provide informative discussions and workshops around this issue, 72,000 women, 34,000 children and 9,000 men sought homeless services in 2016-2017 due to Domestic Vio-
