Sign the Sydney Statement

The Sydney Statement is an interfaith charter that details how to engage in interfaith relations with others – in daily life, in acting together for the common good, in sharing knowledge about each other's religions and spirituality – and to promote interreligious dialogue within one's own community.

Youth PoWR (Parliament of the World's Religions) generated the content of the statement. Everyone is invited to sign up to its values, principles and commitments on its dedicated website.

It invites signatories to make twentyone practical commitments based on these values and principles. See notice board for more details.

Palm Sunday & Beyond

On Palm Sunday we remembered Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on a donkey. Jesus accepts death on a cross rather than engaging in violence. This is the basis of the Palm Sunday tradition of action in favour of peace and non-violent alternatives for addressing social, ecological, economic and political issues.

The Reign or Dominion of God is not just a future event for which we simply wait. It is already present and active among us. God invites us to participate in its unfolding until, in the fullness of time, God brings it to completion. We don't just wish for a peaceful world, peaceful communities and peaceful families — we are called to live in a way that brings these things into being. It is a way of making the kingdom of justice, love and peace announced by the Prince of Peace manifest in the world.

We pray for justice and peace in Myanmar.
