Woman of the Wallaby Track

From the success of Penola school and with new novices training Fr Woods called Mary to open a school in Adelaide, so the new institute could become known. Pauperism was increasing and the poor came to love Mary and the sisters. Mary became convinced she would have to make her difficult way through life without Fr Woods help.

On the feast of The Assumption Mary took her vows for the Sisterhood of St Joseph - obedience, chastity and poverty. Mary made a fourth vow - to promote the love of Jesus Christ in the hearts of little children, as Sister Mary of the Cross.

Despite the mischief done to the Institute by it's opponents, attacks made upon her reputation and excommunication, Mother Mary never showed the least disposition

Mary to be vindictive. broke new ground and schools opened across Australia and New Zealand. Many of us benefited have from Mary's sisters "promoting the love of Jesus in our hearts."
