Thanks to the parish priests and parishioners for supporting Alternative Housing for low paid workers on the Central Coast. Please note that none of the developments in the local papers are related to this policy.

The policy is a new initiative and will take at least 18 months to begin to make an impact. It is planned to be introduced over 10 years. It involves mixed tenure and a diversity of housing in the private market and some properties managed by local Not for Profit groups.

Local people can not compete with the rise in housing costs. Victims of domestic violence, sudden illness, and full single pensioners will benefit. Your efforts will make our community more inclusive.
