Affordable Housing

Louise Greenway from the Central Coast Council asked me to forward this to parishioners, since some of the letters she received had incomplete or no address but referred to the parish. Vince.

Many of your parishioners have written to me regarding their support for Affordable Housing in the Region. Some have also indicated that there is a need for crisis accommodation and measures to address homelessness. Correspondence received by me has been forwarded to Council staff for consideration.

The public submission period closed on 21 December 2018.

A briefing has been scheduled for 29 January 2019, where Councillors will receive an update on community and industry comments received during the public exhibition period. Councillors will also be provided with a workshop with the consultants, Judith Stubbs & Associates, to finalise actions within the draft Strategy

Affordable housing is a complex and vexed problem for our local community, and the issue affects a vast range of local residents. Using the accepted definition of housing stress (paying more than 30% of your gross income on housing needs), around one in five of our local households are in this situation.
