Social Justice Plan on Laudato Si

Marking the end of the Year for Laudato Si, and to coincide with World Environment Day on 5 June, Pope Francis has launched a seven-year action plan. This will focus on seven sectors: families, parishes, schools, hospitals, businesses, organisations, and religious orders.

Pope Francis said, "Our selfishness, our indifference, and our irresponsible ways are threatening the future of our children"

The first year will be dedicated to "drawing up concrete action plans" followed by "five years of concrete action" with the final year dedicated to "praise and thank God"

Our Australian Catholic Bishops' Social Justice Statement will be on the same theme. It is entitled "The Cry of the Earth, The Cry of the Poor" and will be released later this year.
