First Holy Communion

Classes resume this Sunday. With the final class on 15 September there will be a rehearsal after Mass. The sacrament of First Eucharist will be celebrated on 22nd September at 10am and 12 noon.

Exaltation of the Holy Cross

This Saturday we celebrate the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross which recalls three historical events: the finding of the True Cross by St Helena the mother of the emperor Constantine; the dedication of churches built by Constantine on the site of the Holy Sepulchre and Mount Calvary; and the restoration of the True Cross to Jerusalem by the emperor Heraclius II. But in a deeper sense, the feast also celebrates the Holy Cross as the instrument of our salvation. This instrument of torture, designed to degrade the worst of criminals, became the life-giving tree that reversed Adam's Original Sin when he ate from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil in the Garden of Eden.
