### The Most Holy Trinity

12th June 2022



Today's Gospel passage speaks of Jesus' promise of the Holy Spirit to His disciples. As explained by the Lord, the work of the Holy Spirit is manifold: that is to guide us into all truth and to give us guidance for future by declaring what is to come. Holy Spirit in turn glorifies Jesus.

The Feast of the Holy Trinity reminds us that there is only one God but three persons each living in harmony and perfect unity. This mystery is not something to argue about or even to study. Holy Trinity is a mystery to understand with a heart not with a head. It is more of something to pray about and live. The Christian lives in the world of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. We need to realize that God is my Father and that we are His Children. God loves me even though I am unworthy of His love. Christ the Son of God is my brother. He died and brought salvation for me. Through Him all other people have become my brothers and sisters. And the Holy Spirit is the bond of love between us all.

Let our prayer to Holy Trinity be that we too may experience the same love and unity which is present in the Most Holy Trinity.

"Given that God the Father is both personal and supremely good, it is proper to think of Him as loving a person from eternity. This other person is the Son and the love between them is the Holy Spirit." - St. Thomas Aquinas (on Trinity)  
"The only way to engage God is to meet one of the three in time. We meet the Father as creator, the Son as redeemer and the Holy Spirit as the dispenser of God's grace" - T. Wilson. (Reflections from Fr. Joy Joseph)
