Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B



Dear parishioners and friends, in the gospel today Jesus' *heart* was moved with pity for those people who were "sheep without a shepherd." This is a beautiful passage of consolation and strength during this Covid lock down period reminding us that we are not forgotten and forsaken. As a parish community your priests, shepherds are with you during this difficult time. You are all in our prayers and remembered on the altar in every Mass we celebrate. You are not left alone and believe we are with you and united in prayer.

Today's Gospel passage presents the sympathetic and merciful heart of Jesus who lovingly invites the apostles to a desolate place for some rest. It teaches that "the mission of the Church should be based on the Gospel of compassion we seek to live and share, from the authority of our commitment to forgiveness and reconciliation; and that leadership, inspired by the wisdom of God, means not dictating and ruling over others but inspiring, providing for and selflessly caring for those whom we are called to lead." Jesus' first act with these shepherd-less sheep was to teach them, then to feed them, and finally to protect the apostles (who were also His sheep), from the storm. This text affirms Jesus' extraordinary availability and his compassion for the needy.

The Christian life is a continuous passage from the presence of God to the presence of people and back to God again. Prayer is essentially listening to God and talking to Him. One of our main problems is that we do not truly allow God the opportunity to speak to us. We also do not know how to "be still and listen." let us remind ourselves that the Christian life consists of meeting with God in the secret place so that we may serve people more effectively in the streets and surroundings.
