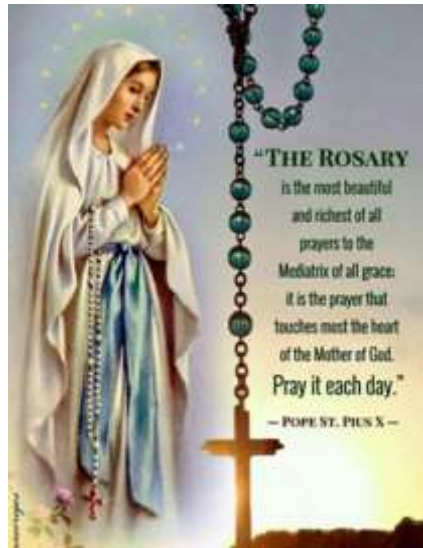

### The Month of the Rosary

As we enter the month of October, which is specially dedicated to Mother Mary, it is proper to reflect about the importance of the most powerful prayer Rosary. The rosary is one of the most cherished prayers of our Catholic Church. Journeying through the Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Luminous mysteries of the rosary, the individual recalls our Lord's incarnation, His life, His passion and death and His resurrection from the dead. In

so doing, the rosary assists us in growing in a deeper appreciation of these mysteries, in uniting our life more closely to our Lord and in imploring His graced assistance to live the faith. We also ask for the prayers of our Blessed Mother, who leads all believers to her Son.

The fact that our Church continues to include the Feast of the Holy Rosary on the liturgical calendar testifies to the importance and goodness of this form of prayer. Archbishop Fulton Sheen said, "The power of the rosary is beyond description. "Never will anyone who prays his rosary every day be led astray. This is a statement that I would gladly sign with my own blood", Says St. Louis de Montfort.

Pope Benedict XVI says, "With rosary, we allow ourselves to be guided by Mary, model of Faith, in meditating on the mysteries of Christ, and day after day we are helped to assimilate the gospel, so that it shapes all our lives".

St. Pope John Paul II said, "The Rosary is my favorite prayer. A marvelous prayer! Marvellous in its simplicity and its depth". Why it is His favorite prayer, he says "to pray the rosary is to hand over our burdens to the merciful hearts of Christ and his mother. And He continues to say when we pray the rosary, we learn three essential things in Christian life. First, from Mary we learn to surrender to God's will in all things. Secondly, we learn to trust even when all hopes seem gone and finally, we learn to love Christ her son and the son of God. Let us stay close to Mother Mary and place our families into the Immaculate heart of Mary.
