Gospel Reflection

The spirit of the Advent season is filled with images of some of the most powerful examples of hope and trust. Two of the most important are the prophet Isaiah and John the Baptist Isaiah speaks of the nearness of God. He proclaims the truth about a God who takes an active part in the daily lives of his people - a God who comes to save. He opens the eyes of the blind, he clears the ears of the deaf, makes the lame walk and the mute speak.

John the Baptist sent his followers to Jesus to find out and to ask what can be expected from him.

Jesus proclaimed a vision of God's truth as it applies to human activity and relationships, proclaiming this truth publicly and courageously and in the face of constant threat and opposition. His mission was one of service to the poor and the desolate and of comforting His people. It was a proclamation that their slavery to sin and death had come to an end. It was a call to rejoice, for like a shepherd feeding his flock, the glory of the Lord was truly revealed.

He sends John's disciples back to report about what they saw. Isaiah's prophecy was fulfilled when people met Christ, "Here is your God... who comes to save you." And like them, we too are called to go and tell what we have seen, heard and experienced in Christ.

People will never believe us until they can see our lives as authentic sign of Jesus' on-going presence in the world, until they see us guiding the footsteps of the blind, carrying the crippled to places where they can receive help, and finding ways to help the voices of the poor be heard.



First Reading Isaiah 35:1-6, 10 A reading from the prophet Isaiah *God himself will come and save us.*

Yes, I tell you, and much more than a prophet: he is the one of whom scripture says: Look, I am going to send my messenger before you; he will prepare your way before you. I tell you solemnly, of all the children born of women, a greater than John the Baptist has never been seen; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he is.'


