Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B

4th July 2021



Today's Gospel reading is from St. Mark. The context of this passage is Jesus' arrival at His hometown Nazareth. Jesus had been preaching, teaching and healing in Judea, Samaria and many other towns and villages of Galilee. Finally, he came to Nazareth where he was brought up. Although he had a great reputation as a prophet all over Palestine, His own people failed to recognize Him and acclaim Him. Instead of admiration He faced scorn. Their attitude was, after all He is a carpenter's son. We know his family background. They could not just accept the fact that God is in their midst and communicates with them through Jesus the carpenter's son.

Jesus was totally disappointed by their scornful attitude. Hence, he said, "No prophet is acceptable in his own country, in his own relations and in his own house." There are several occasions we have rejected God's chosen messengers. Those who accept the call of God and seek to follow Him will face indifference, hostility, contempt, scorn, weakness, hardship, persecution, insults and rejection. It may also happen that we may have faced rejection from our own family or community.

Jesus has shown us the way. We need to avoid magnifying the rejection. Rejection need not be a forecast of our future, and it must not become a self-fulfilling prophecy. Rejection in the past need not be a predictor of rejection in the future. We need to avoid allowing rejection to derail our dreams and instead choose to persist in following God's Way, doing His Will. We need to learn from our rejections. We are not perfect, and we do not always get it right, but we need to keep coming back until we do get it right. Every rejection can be a lesson if we stay open to new possibilities and new opportunities. He did not stop His ministry because the people of Nazareth rejected Him. He did not blame others or God for His failures and lack of acceptance. Nazareth was certainly a learning experience for Jesus.
