"John the Baptist's call to repentance"

Today's Gospel gives us an account of John the Baptist's invitation to prepare the way of the Lord. In view of Christ's coming John urges us to prepare the way for Christ by giving our lives a new orientation, a complete turnabout. The repentance that is asked of us is not merely a turning away from sin but rather a change of heart. Hence to repent would mean that we recognize our brokenness and our need for redemption and turn to God. Humankind in general is broken, fragmented, damaged and wounded by sin.

Hence, we need to recognize our own brokenness to be saved from the situation. John proclaims Jesus to be one who will fulfill the prophecy of Isaiah that all humankind will see the salvation of God. To prepare for His coming John invites us to prepare the way of the Lord. That is by making His paths straight. All that prevents His smooth coming has to be done away with: valleys shall be filled, mountains and hills shall be levelled and crooked ways have to be made straight.

We need to prepare the way for the Messiah in our hearts: We have to fill in the "valleys" of our souls which have resulted from our shallow prayer life and a minimalist way of living out our Faith. We have to straighten whatever crooked paths we've been walking like habitual sins or anger. If we have been involved in some dishonest practices at work or at home, we are called to straighten them out and make restitution. If we have been harbouring grudges or hatred, or failing to be reconciled with others, now is the time to clear away all the debris. If we have been pushing God off to the side of our road, now is the time for us to get our priorities straight.
