THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

4th June, 2023



Today's Gospel speaks of God's love for humankind and the promise of eternal life to the one who believes in the Son of God. Jesus before He ascended to heaven, promised the disciples that He would send the Holy Spirit—the spirit of truth—to guide them to all truth. God the Father spoke to us through His beloved Son. God the Father continues to speak to us through the Holy Spirit. The trinitarian God points to a community of love. The most Holy Trinity actualises as the creative love of the Father, the redemptive love of the Son and the sanctifying love of the Holy Spirit. Hence the most Holy Trinity is not a puzzle but a relationship of LOVE.

In God the Father we recognize the one in whom we live and move and have our being. In God the Son we recognize the one who is the way, the truth and the life. In God the Holy Spirit we recognize the one who helps us to pray and the one who guides us in our life's journey. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith, the light that enlightens them. It is the most fundamental and essential teaching and every prayer and sacrament in the church begin with the trinitarian formula—“in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” The whole history of salvation is identical with the history of the way and the means by which the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, reveals himself to men "and reconciles and unites with himself those who turn away from sin".

To understand the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity - one God and three persons - is not easy. We need the divine grace to go into the depth of this mystery. Thus the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity reminds us that the Most Holy Trinity is a mystery and God's unending love for humankind is expressed through this mystery of the Most Holy Trinity.
