THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY, 7TH JUNE 2020

We are nearly halfway through the calendar year and have journeyed together through the liturgy from Ash Wednesday to Pentecost; commemorating the life, death and resurrection of Jesus, his ascension to the Father, and the sending of the Holy Spirit. This year has also been unique, as we find ourselves struggling with church lockdowns, the absence of the Eucharist and the lack of communal participation due to global pandemic. Still, today we have the opportunity to pause for a bit and try to draw comfort from God's Spirit within us... to draw strength from the community of Love which we call "The Trinity."

Our God is personal, and intimately bound up in who we are and what we do. We acknowledge Him as Creator and Lord, as architect of the universe and author of life. His Word became flesh so that He could enter fully into all of the dimensions and experiences of our human journey in the person of Jesus, son of Mary.

The readings today do not attempt to "explain" the Trinity to us, but they do reveal how God works: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." It is not a matter of doctrinal definition, but rather the experience of a loving God who does not give up on us, even when we give up on ourselves and Him. This enfleshed love can come to any of us and transform us. No one is left out of this loving embrace of God revealed to us in Christ.

God reaches out to us through Jesus, His Son and our brother, and who is the full sign of God's love for all people. We may not be able to define this God of ours, but this much we do know - our God is merciful, gracious and relentless in His love.

We do not celebrate a "doctrine" today. We celebrate the active presence of a God who continues to pour out His love on this community, journeying in faith.



Message from Bishop Anthony

The Archdiocese of Sydney has developed a site to assist parishes throughout Australia as they respond to the easing of restrictions and the introduction of public Masses again. It is called <u>massregister.com.au.</u>

Bishop Anthony has recommended its use throughout our own Diocese of Broken Bay – though it is for individual parishes to consider its merit and to decide on its implementation.

Mass register.com.au is a site on which we can ask those people who are nominating to attend our parish Masses or who are intending to visit our church to log-in their details. Please note that the site does not allow people to nominate for a particular Mass on a particular day. This would have to be done through other local means, such as through the parish office. However, it is most convenient way by which parishes can be assisted to keep a log of all those who are attending their site.

Places of Worship

The following limitations apply to the number of people allowed within the premises:

For a Mass, a Baptism, a funeral, a memorial, or other religious service, or for private worship - the lesser of:

50 persons; or the total number of persons calculated by allowing 4 square metres of space for each person on the premises.

For a **wedding** the lesser of 20 Persons; or the total number of persons calculated by allowing 4 square metres of space for each person on the premises.
