Heavenly Father and Eternal Shepherd, you watch over and govern your flock with vigilance and concern.


In your immense love, grant to your Church a pastor who will please you by his holiness and aid us with his unfailing care.



The Labyrinth of Chartres, a Cathedral in France, is part of the pilgrim's quest on their journey to the holy land. The Chartres Cathedral labyrinth is the most famous of these, but labyrinths began to appear all over Europe in the 12th century.

The Chartres Labyrinth was almost certainly built in the early 13th century and became a symbol for pilgrims, who walk the labyrinth as part of their pilgrimage.
