Permission has been given to make the change; the Parish has been consulted and most agree with the new times of **7.30am** and **9.30am**; and this proposal has been sent to the Bishop for his approval.

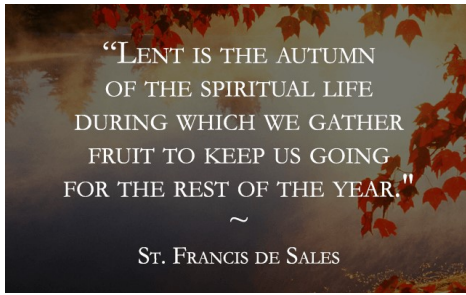
When we have this, we will set a date for the changeover; the new times will be well advertised in the parish before any change happens; and a review will be conducted six months after the change.

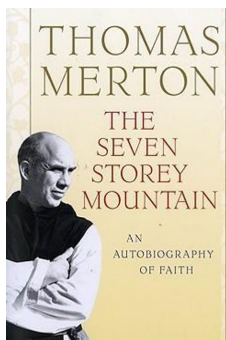

Thomas Merton was the author of the most famous book ever written by an American Catholic, writes Michael Mott, his biographer. **The Seven Storey Mountain** became a classic of thought and faith in the postwar years. book has often been compared to St Augustine's Confessions. It is really a conversion story and outlines Merton's search for God in contemplation. He was influenced by John of the Cross.

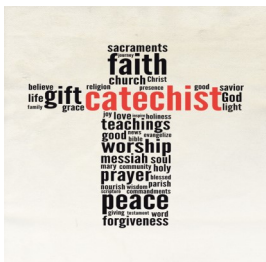
