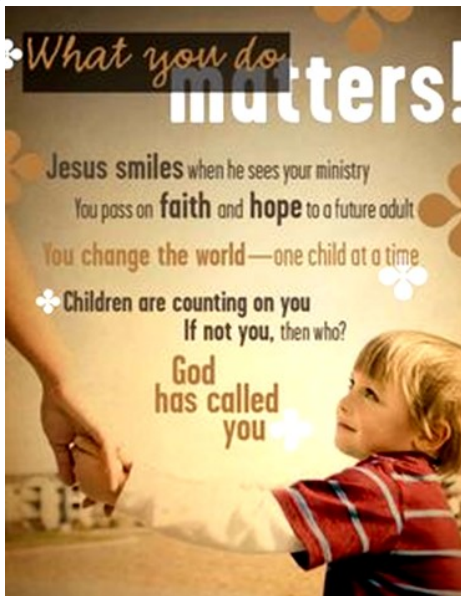

We believe that those Holy Souls for whom we pray will continue to pray for us after they have been released from Purgatory. If we live Christian lives, we too will likely find ourselves in Purgatory someday, and our acts of charity toward the Holy Souls now will ensure that they remember us, before the throne of God when we are most in need of prayers. It's a comforting thought, and one that should encourage us, especially in this month of November, to offer our prayers for the Holy Souls. The Church offers [a special plenary indulgence](#), applicable only to the souls in [Purgatory](#), on [All Souls Day](#).

To be able to gain an indulgence, the faithful must be in the state of grace receiving the **sacrament of confession**, either eight days before or after, receive **Holy Communion** on that day, and recite **prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father** (one Our Father, one Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added). We can also obtain an indulgence by visiting the Cemetery between 1st and the 8th November and reciting prayers.

Plenary Council. 2020. In what, for the Catholic Church, is an amazing development, the Amazon Synod has made some ground-breaking recommendations. The Synod was held in Rome in October this year and presided over personally by the Pope. It consisted of Bishops representing 10 South American countries in the Amazon region, all of them predominantly Catholic. Two major recommendations have come out of the Synod.

1. Married priests. By vote of 128 to 41 the Synod approved the ordination of married men to the priesthood. More than that a number of Synod Representatives argued that this should be a universal rule not just a new rule for the Amazon region. This is a major challenge to the 1000-year-old rule of clerical celibacy. It was not rejected by the Pope who promised to consider it and give a reply before the end of this year. The significance of this is enormous. It will certainly have considerable influence over the Australian plenary Council deliberations in 2020. Many regard it as a crack in the wall clerical celibacy which will simply and inevitably spread through the universal Church.
2. Women deacons. By vote of 137 to 30 the Synod approved the opening of the permanent diaconate for women. When Pope John Paul II said the Catholic Church could never ordain women as priests he left open expressly the question of whether women could be ordained as deacons. The present Pope in 2016 set up a commission to examine the diaconate for women. The commissioners reported but the Pope has not made or announced any decision. In reply to the Synod the Pope announced he would recall the commission to continue consideration of opening the permanent diaconate to women. This would not be confined to the Amazon region but would be for the whole Catholic Church throughout the world.
