Changing Mass Times

Since 2022 the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) has been discussing a proposal to decrease the number of Sunday morning Masses from three to two. Bishop Randazzo asked us to wait till the Central Coast Discernment Process had progressed, and now we have now been given permission to move to two Sunday morning Masses.

Why move from three to two Masses on Sunday morning?

There are a number of considerations:

- 1. With social distancing we have learnt to spread out and to use the whole church when we attend Mass resulting in an experience of being distant from each other. The church building is very large and is only ever full to capacity on major feasts. While still allowing for social distancing, two Masses would create a greater sense of shared participation in the Eucharist.
- 2. The Parish is seeking to strengthen its sense of community, consistent with its mission statement "that all experience a sense of belonging." Hence everyone is invited to the new morning tea after 8.30am and 10am Mass. The rearrangement of Sunday mornings to two Masses would provide morning tea for everyone and encourage more opportunities for intermingling.
- 3. A comparison to our adjacent parishes shows that Terrigal has three Sunday morning Masses and the others have only one or two:

Terrigal: 7am 8.30am 10am The Entrance: 8am 9.30am Gosford: 7.30am 9.30am

Kincumber: 9am

- 4. The parish now has only one priest. The present system of four Sunday Masses, with three on a Sunday morning, followed by baptisms, was a manageable workload when we had two priests, as we often had in the past. Given the shortage of clergy in Australia we cannot expect another priest in Terrigal to share the workload.
- 5. The new arrangement would reduce the number of altar servers, musicians, readers and collectors needed for Sunday Masses. We have recently had appeals for new ministers, with minimal success. This new arrangement would be of assistance in organising parish ministries.

Permission has been given for this change to two Masses on Sunday morning and we now need to decide on the new starting times.

Vigil Mass at 5pm on Saturday will remain unchanged because a good children's ministry is developing around this Mass; its numbers have remained high; and this time is less taxing for one priest.

The proposed new Sunday Mass times are 7.30am and 9.30am.

At their meeting last week the PPC discussed various combinations of Mass times, and the advantages and disadvantages of each, but ultimately decided that fairest way to move forward, with the least disruption to the parish, is to consolidate the starting times of Masses. So instead of extending these times over three hours as in the past (from 7am to 10am) we will now extend the start times over two hours (from 7.30am to 9.30am).

Parishioner concerns

The PPC is now seeking feedback from the parish about the proposed times and asks if any parishioner has substantive concerns about this decision, please speak with a member of the PPC during this week, and before Friday 9 February.

The needs of the deanery have to be considered.

The Mass times at Our Lady Star of the Sea, Terrigal also affect the neighbouring parishes and these proposed times need to go to the deanery and the diocese before they are approved. Gosford Mass times are also 7.30am and 9.30am; and The Entrance has a 9.30am Mass on Sunday mornings.

When will our times change?

There will be no change in Mass times until approval has been given by the Bishop. When we have this, the new times will be well advertised in the parish before any change happens.

Is the change permanent?

The presumption is that this change will be permanent, but the diocesan policy requires a review after six months. We will have this review to consider the impact of the change in times on the parish







The book for February is C S Lewis' Reflections on the Psalms. "He divines the meaning behind these timeless poetic verses, making clear their significance in our daily lives, and reminding us of their power to illuminate moments of grace."



"I am no Hebraist, no higher critic, no ancient historian, no archeologist. I write for the unlearned about things in which I am unlearned myself." So says Lewis in the introduction to his book, yet no one is more qualified to reflect on the psalms as poetry which is how they should be read he argues.

In March we will be reflecting on the history of original sin in Western culture. Born Bad by James Boyce traces this history from Adam and Eve all the way to Adam Smith and Richard Dawkins. This book is not a defence or criticism of the idea of original sin, Boyce merely suggests that without understanding this mystery we will be "incomprehensible to ourselves."


