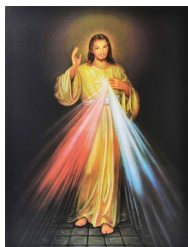

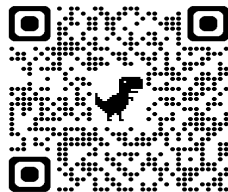

Easter House Blessing

Begin with the sign of the cross: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Leader: When Christ took flesh through the Virgin Mary, he made his home with us. Today we rejoice in his resurrection: by rising from the tomb, he gives us new life and hope.

We pray now that Christ will enter our home and bless it with his presence. May he always be here among us; may he nurture our love for each other, share in our joys, and comfort us in our sorrows. Inspired by his teachings and example, we seek to make our home, before all else, a dwelling place of love, diffusing far and wide the goodness of Christ.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

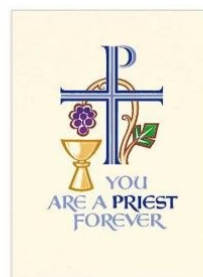

The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence. A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.

Bookclub

Our book club in April will be reading C S Lewis' book **Mere Christianity**. Based on a series of lectures that Lewis gave at the invitation of the BBC, only months after the London blitz. These lectures were eventually collected and published as a book, which became immensely popular as an introduction to Christian faith. A contemporary of Tolkien, Dorothy Sayers, Evelyn Waugh and G K Chesterton his books, particularly the Narnia series, have been read by millions. They give expression to this 'Christ haunted world' and remind us of what is truly important.

In May we will read Bishop Robert Barron's little book on **Saint Thomas Aquinas**. Published by Word on Fire, Aquinas is, along with St Augustine, one of the most prominent theologians in the catholic faith. Theology is not an academic exercise but a matter of spiritual life or death, and so Bishop Barron reminds us that at the core of Aquinas' writing is a deep love of the Lord. 
