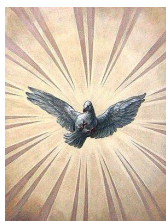

Bookclub

Last Friday the bookclub met to discuss C S Lewis book *The Screwtape Letters*. It is a book that has enchanted readers for eighty years. It is hard not to read it without a sense that *Screwtape* (Lewis) had each individual reader in his focus. It is full of useful quips and insights. -“Prosperity knits a man to the World. He feels that’s he is ‘finding his place in it’, while really it is finding its place in him”.

All acknowledged that it was difficult to enter the world view where what was right was wrong, what was good was bad and our Lord was referred to as the Enemy, but once the reader aligned themselves with Lewis’ diabolical conceit, the lessons in temptation were enlightening.

The book to be discussed at the next meeting on Friday June 25th in the parish offices will be Greg Sheridan’s book “God is Good for You: A Defence of Christianity for Troubled Times”. This is a timely book to read given the current emphasis on evangelisation. The book chosen for July is Russell Shaw’s book “Eight Popes and the Crisis of Modernity” This is a book which takes up the central question of our day: how to understand the postmodern culture and the ‘dictatorship of relativism’ and how to witness the Gospel in it. He also told the people that the Jesus who has been crucified is the Lord and was raised from the dead, which "cut them to the heart." When they asked what they should do, Peter exhorted them to repent of their sins and to be baptised. According to the account in Acts, about 3,000 people were baptised following Peter's sermon.

Vox Populi - The Voice of the People

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. The Church actually celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday 24 June this year, 19 days after Pentecost.

It is a “moveable feast”, celebrated after the Corpus Christi octave. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is one of the most widely practiced and well-known devotions, taking Jesus’ physical heart as the representation of His divine love for humanity – emphasising the unmitigated love, compassion and long-suffering of the heart of Christ towards humanity.

This feast wasn’t always on the calendar and took many centuries before it was established and spread throughout the world.

St Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun and mystic, received private revelations from Jesus on 16 June 1675, asking her to specifically promote a feast that honoured His Sacred Heart.

The first time there was a liturgical feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was on 20 October, 1672.

The first country to institute a liturgical feast was Poland and then in a decree from the Sacred Congregation of Rites on 23 August 1856, Pope Pius IX Established the feast for the universal Church.

St John Paul II, a great devotee of the Sacred Heart, said: “This feast reminds us of the mercy of the love of God for the people of all times.”

The faithful are encouraged to discover the riches hidden in the Heart of Jesus that gives hope and trust and to love our neighbours.

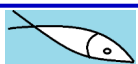
