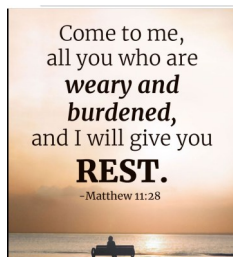

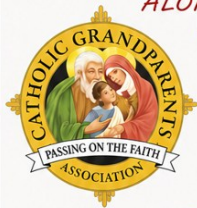

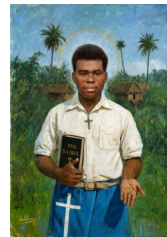

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Saint Peter To Rot Feast Day 7th July



The Meaning of His Name: In the local Tolai language "Rot" translates to "road" or "path". Devotees frequently state that Saint Peter To Rot is "showing us the road" to faith.

World War II Ministry: When Japanese forces occupied the region in 1942, they imprisoned foreign missionaries. As a

layman, To Rot was left in charge of his parish, continuing to baptise children, witness marriages, and lead secret prayer services in caves

Martyr for Marriage: In 1945, legal restrictions were placed on Christian worship, and occupying forces sought to reintroduce polygamy. To Rot publicly denounced the practice to defend the sanctity of monogamous Christian marriage. He was arrested and secretly executed by lethal injection at age 33.

Sainthood: He was beatified by Pope John Paul II in 1995. Pope Francis approved his cause, and he was officially canonised as a saint on **19 October 2025** by Pope Leo XIV. His official feast day is celebrated on **7 July**

Our neighbouring parish Kincumber has a first class relic of St Peter To Rot . Mass on his feast day at Kincumber 9.30am on Tuesday. You can visit the relic any time at Holy Spirit Parish, Kincumber.

Bookclub

The book for July is Chesterton's **A Man Who Was Thursday**. He very often reads as epigrams strung together by deep insights and childlike wonder. "Because children have abounding vitality, because they are in spirit, fierce and free, therefore they want things repeated and unchanged. They always say, "Do it again"; and the grown-up person does it again, until he's nearly dead. For grown-up people are not strong enough to exult in monotony. But perhaps God is strong enough to exult in monotony. It is possible that God says every morning, "Do it again" to the sun; and every evening, "Do it again" to the moon. It may not be automatic necessity that makes all daisies alike; it may be that God makes every daisy separately, but has never got tired of making them. It may be that He has the eternal appetite of infancy; for we have sinned and grown old, and our Father is younger than we. The repetition in Nature may not be a mere recurrence; it may be a theatrical encore." Reading Chesterton can be a bit like a child saying "Do it again."

In August our book club will be reading C S Lewis autobiography **Surprised by Joy** and in September we will read Pope Leo's first encyclical **Magnifica Humanitas**.

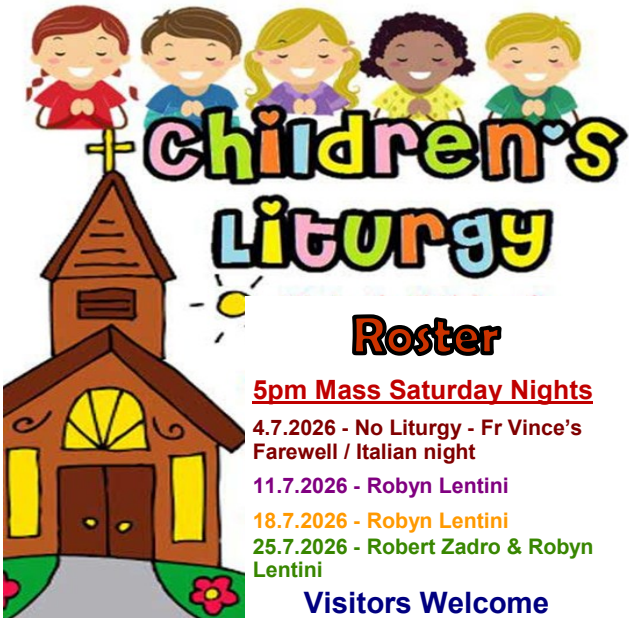
What is spiritual direction?

In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence. A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.
