## Bookclub—Orthodoxy

### 4pm Friday 25 March Parish Office

Masie Ward, who wrote the definitive biography of Chesterton, described how "Gilbert said once he was willing to start anywhere and develop from anything the whole of his philosophy." He maintained throughout his life, a wonder of creation. "The repetition in nature may not be a mere recurrence, it may be a theatrical encore." This was how he looked at life. No subject matter was out of bounds. He truly believed that one could start anywhere and find God. "You cannot evade the issue of God whether you talk about pigs or binomial theory," he wrote. For Chesterton, the Kingdom of God is at hand. "I for one, he wrote, should never be astonished if the next twist of a street led me to the heart of that maze in which all the mystics are lost" Yet at one point in his life one of those turns led him to an encounter with evil in the person of one of his companions. It had a terrifying and lingering impact for the rest of his life. Orthodoxy, our next book for discussion, is a spiritual voyage of sorts where Chesterton tries to make sense of the cosmos while surrounded by the pressures of the surrounding culture.

"I did, like all other solemn little boys, try to be in advance of the age...And I found that I was eighteen hundred years behind it...When I fancied that I stood alone I really was in the ridiculous position of being backed up by all Christendom...I did try to found a heresy of my own; and when I put the finishing touches to it, I discovered it was orthodoxy.

Join us at the next book club for this exciting and challenging encounter with The Apostle of Common Sense.


