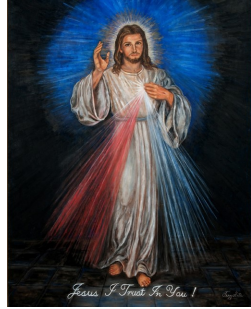

Giving in the Parish

We have **two regular collections** in the parish each weekend.

The First Collection goes to a common fund (**Pastoral Revenue**) across all diocesan parishes and is used to support the Bishop and all the priests (active and retired) in the Diocese. Donations for Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals and Easter and Christmas offerings also go to the Pastoral Revenue.

The Second Collection (**Church Account**) stays in the parish to meet all our expenses. Rents, planned giving, regular direct debits and other donations (unless explicitly directed elsewhere) go to the Church Account. Funds from the account built, and is now used to maintain the church, hall, offices, presbytery and grounds. It pays for all our running costs including insurance, employment and office, church and pastoral expenses. Donations through *Tap 'n' Go* in the church and *Donate Now* on our website go to the Church Account.

All other **special collections** go to the charity or activity that is advertised when we have the appeal.

Thank-you all for your on-going generosity to all these collections.

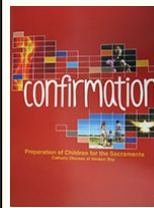

CONFIRMATION 2024



The Sacrament of Confirmation is offered to baptised children in Year 3 and older. Confirmation is usually the next Sacrament after Baptism, and before Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

STEP 1: ENROLMENT

Enrolment will take place at the church after the Masses on the :

Saturday 27th April after 5.00pm,

Sunday 28th April after 7.30am & 9.30am

Enrolments will also be accepted through the Parish Office from Monday 8th to Friday 12th April during office hours (9am - 5pm).

Please Bring your completed enrolment form and a copy of your child's Baptism certificate (if not Baptised at Terrigel), plus \$25.00 to cover the cost of the activity book, certificate etc.

STEP 2: INPUT SESSION FOR PARENTS

This session will be held in the church at on **Wednesday 1st May at 7pm.**

Please arrive at 6.45pm so we can distribute the resources. We aim to make this a relaxed, spiritual, informative evening. We will finish by 8pm.

It is essential that at least one parent comes to this session. If there is some serious reason you are unable to attend, please let Fr Vince or Janette know through the Parish Office.

STEP 4: PARISH PRESENTATIONS

Children receiving Confirmation will be presented to the Parish at all the Masses over this weekend. Mass times are Saturday 18th May at 5.00pm, and Sunday 19th May at 7.30am and 9.30am

STEP 5: CONFIRMATION DAY

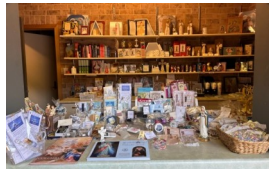

Book Club

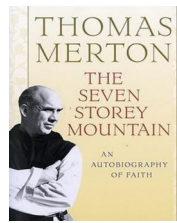
The next book club meeting will take place on 26th May at 1600 hrs in the parish offices.

Evelyn Waugh had a lot to say about Merton's skill as a writer but of this particular book he wrote that "it may well prove to be of permanent interest in the history of religious experience." Graham Greene called it "an autobiography with a pattern and meaning for us all." Clare Boothe Luce predicted, "it is to a book like this that man will turn one hundred years from now to find out what went on in the heart of man in this cruel century." It is the twentieth century bookend to Theresa of Avila and John of the Cross.

In May we will be reading **Born Bad** by James Boyce and in June we will be reading Jacques Phillipa's book on prayer called **Time for God**.

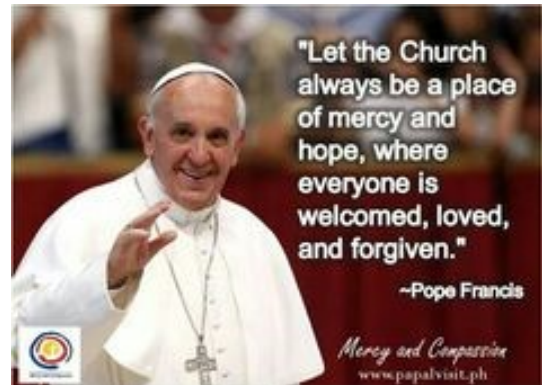


Men's Bushwalking Group

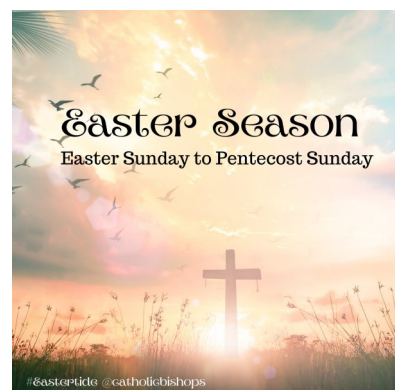

New Mass Times ... Ministers needed

This weekend we celebrate the introduction of the new Sunday Mass times. We first started this process over two years ago, but only in the last month did we receive the final approval from the Bishop. It was a long process involving lengthy consultation, approval from the Central Coast Dean and finally submission and approval from Bishop Randazzo. Naturally the new Mass times will not suit everyone but it is to be hoped that parish can adjust happily to them over time.

Up until now Terrigal was the only Central Coast parish with a single priest and 3 Sunday morning masses. Change had to happen and we appreciate everyone's forbearance and assistance in making it happen.

This is now an opportunity to seek greater engagement from the congregation.

We need more servers. We need more collectors. We need more readers.

Everyone is asked to see if they can participate. The Parish only works well if everyone works well. These responsibilities are not onerous and are well within the capacity of almost everyone. So please consider this request and see it for what it is – an opportunity to be more fully engaged in God's work.

In St Matthew's Gospel our Saviour Christ sees the great need in the community for his divine message. He also sees the need for others to assist him in spreading his message. We worship God by our prayers but also by our personal engagement in his work.

When he saw the crowds he had compassion for them because they were harassed and helpless like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples "the harvest is great but the labourers are few. Pray to the Lord God that he may send labourers to gather in his harvest. (Matthew 9:36 – 38)
