



Count of Mass Attendance

Through-out the Diocese during the month of May the number of people attending Sunday Masses will be counted. The count is usually done in the middle of Mass, by those doing the collection. This has been done in Broken Bay for more than 20 years now and the changes in the numbers attending Mass are used as an indicator of the performance of a parish and for future allocation of resources.

International Survey of Catholic Women.

The International Survey of Catholic Women was undertaken in 2022 in response to a call for submissions to the 2021-2024 world wide Synod of Bishops themed for a "Synodal Church".

The Synod called by Pope Francis is to be held in Rome. Its purpose is to develop a church based on the sense of the faithful- 'sensus fideli."

The emerging role of women in the 21st century church is one of the major issues.

The international survey drew on 17,200 responses from Catholic women in 104 countries.

The Pope has already made clear his views on the importance of the advancement of women in the church as it faces up to the massive decline in religious observance in First World countries like Australia.

This survey is a valuable insight into the views of women and an important foundation to the world wide Synod. It is well worth reading.






