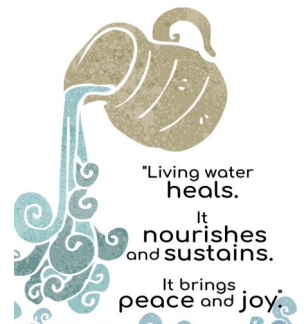

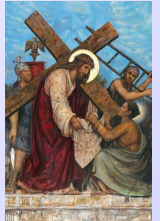

On Good Friday **abstinence from meat** is to
be observed by those who have completed
their fourteenth year of age. Those who are
aged between 18 and 60 are also required to
fast on these days. To "fast" means eating two
small meals and one normal meal, and nothing
else during the day.

On all other **Fridays in Lent** the law of the
common practice of penance is fulfilled by an
act of prayer, self-denial or helping others.
Between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday
(at the end of Easter) all the faithful are obliged
to receive **Holy Communion** and to **confess**
any grave sins.

Lord Jesus, born in poverty, teach us to see You in every exhausted worker, every pensioner going cold, every young adult trapped at home.

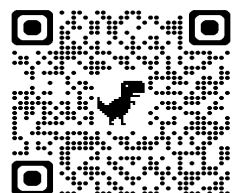



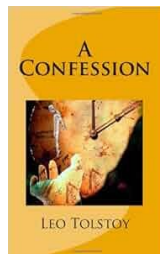
