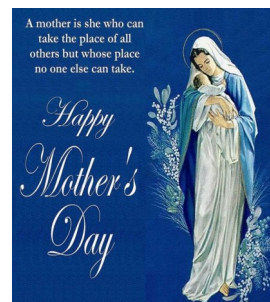

On Friday evening, over 300 young people gathered with Bishop Anthony Randazzo at Praisefest, to officially launch Broken Bay's pilgrimage to World Youth Day in 2023. Held at the Light of Christ Centre in Waitara, the evening was hosted by Catholic Youth Broken Bay, the 'Glorious' team (a Broken Bay community of creatives) and a host of volunteers. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one on one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.

BOOKCLUB 4pm Friday 27th May

C S Lewis said of reading great literature "We want to see with other eyes, to imagine with other imaginations, to feel with other hearts, as well as with our own. Like the night sky in the Greek poem, I see with a myriad eyes, but it is still I who see. Here, as in worship, in love, in moral action, and in knowing, I transcend myself; and am never more myself than when I do." We become the characters in the books we read, and this is not always something we relish. The discussion at our bookclub of Evelyn Waugh's masterpiece *Brideshead Revisited* was both fascinating and riveting. The book was written during WWII, a time of privation and threatening disaster. Waugh came to regard the book as a panegyric over an empty coffin. It was difficult to draw any inspiration from characters that seemed Catholic in name only. Yet the discussion, helped along with Fuller's walnut cake and anchovy toast, allowed that the Hound of Heaven requires so very little to flood us with grace. So despite the fact that we would not identify with these characters there was some joy in knowing they ended up at the right place in the end.

The next book for discussion will be C S Lewis' *The Screwtape Letters*. It is the book that made his international reputation many years before the Narnia series. It is satirical and great fun. You are so welcome to come and join us at the Parish office at 4pm on the 27th May.

Vox Episcopi – The Voice of the Bishop

This Sunday, 8 May is World Day of Prayer for Vocations – marking its 59th anniversary. It is also known as Good Shepherd Sunday.

The motivation for this day is found in both the Gospels of Matthew (9:38) and Luke (10:2) when Jesus says "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborer's into his harvest."

There are four vocations in our Church uses to help discern God's plan: marriage, single life, priesthood and religious life and God calls us to respond freely and generously to His call.

However, World Day of Prayer for vocations is an opportunity to celebrate and pray for vocations to ordained ministry and religious life in all its forms.

In the Diocese of Broken Bay we have 7 seminarians and 3 Diaconate Aspirants. As a community we need to wrap ourselves around their formation.

Everyone in the Church has ownership of their process which is multi-dimensional – the human, spiritual, intellectual and pastoral – and they interrelate, and interconnect with each other.

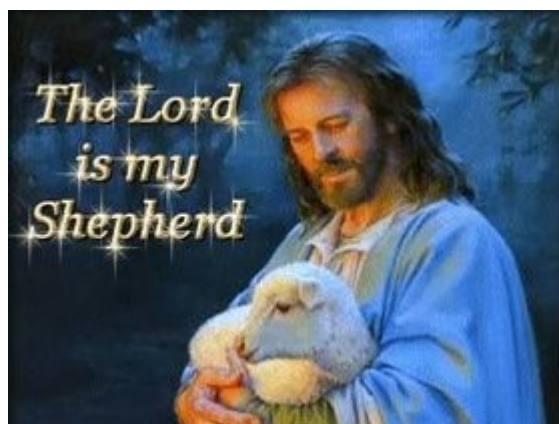
In my years as a priest and bishop I have served as a vocations director, seminary rector and episcopal vicar for formation with a particular focus on the formation of seminarians, young clergy, and the ongoing formation of priests. I know those discerning a vocation today have seen the challenges the Church has faced and the shift in culture but still they come forward. I have also heard those considering a vocation say that prayers, their own as well as others, are critical to their discernment.

Even once a decision has been made to pursue the priesthood, diaconate, missionary or religious life, the continual prayers of the faithful for the grace to persevere in holiness are appreciated and welcomed.

Please pray, on this Vocations Sunday, for our seminarians and deacons as they continue on their journey, and pray that the Lord will bless the Diocese of Broken Bay with more vocations.

Sunday is also special for all the mothers in the Diocese. I pray you and your families have a very special Mother's Day, and even if your mother cannot be with you I will pray in gratitude for all those who have given new life.

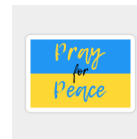

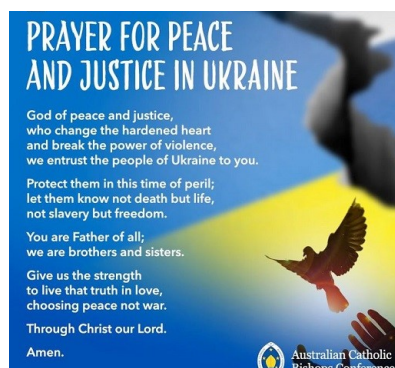
