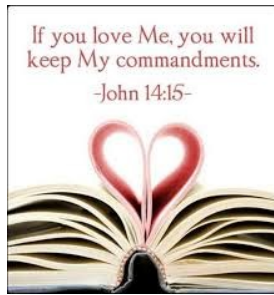

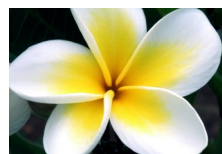

There will be another Mass count this weekend for the month of May. Thank you in advance for your co operation.

From Fr Vince

Last weekend I announced that on 30 June I will be leaving Terrigal Parish, retiring from the administrative duties of Parish Priest, to be available for another ministry. Let me explain what has happened.

Last year I spoke with Bishop Anthony, requesting that when my appointment at Terrigal concludes I would like to begin a sacramental ministry to those who no longer go to Mass, but still approach the church for the sacraments. These people can have particular needs and, belonging nowhere, sometimes find it difficult to connect with a priest, and are often lost to the church. I want to be available to celebrate the sacraments for them, so they know that they belong with us.

Bishop Anthony agreed to support me in this ministry, and before he leaves for Rome, has proposed that I retire from parish duties on 30 June 2026.

This is all very sudden, and I appreciate that it might be a bit unsettling for some people. It also means change for me and I am making plans for the future. I will communicate these arrangements with you when I know what is happening. We don't know yet what arrangements are being made for the parish.

Again, we will communicate these with you when we know them.

Change is always difficult. I have loved being your Parish Priest and am sad to be leaving the parish. Yet, I am convinced that this is part of the Lord's plan and am open to all that might come with this new ministry.

I thank everyone for your affirmation and support for me and for this new venture.

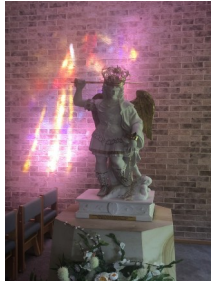

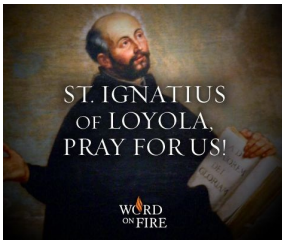
