PLENARY COUNCIL

Calling all Catholics. Your Church wants to hear your voice.

Ash Wednesday, 6 March 2019 is the cut off date for lay submissions to the Plenary Council.
So far over 40,000 laity have either come together to make, as part of a group, a submission or made individual submissions.

In Terrigal parish 86 people participated in the 2018 group submissions day (17 November) and 16 have made individual written submissions.

There are no right or wrong views. Every view is valued and every view will go forward.

After the Ash Wednesday cut off date I will publish in the Bulletin anonymous summaries of Terrigal parishioners' views. I will also be forwarding the group summaries together with a copy of each individual submission to the Plenary Council secretariat but without the authors' name.

There is still a month to go.

If you have not made your own views known or wish to add to views already expressed there is still time. Just send them in to the Parish office or put them on the collection plate marked "Plenary Council".

We all accept the fact that like all organizations the Church needs to adapt to the changes in Society. We cannot stay as we are. We cannot return to what we were.

We either adapt or perish. The recent successful visit by the Pope to a majority Muslim country (the UAE) shows the rate of global change and the Pope's determination to adapt the Church to it.

The Plenary Council consultations have been widely drawn.

According to Catholic News "meetings have been held throughout the country including jails and schools"

Again according to Catholic News the Melbourne Archdiocese held a gathering for "all LGBTI Catholics... to consider topics like how welcome LGBTI Catholics feel in parish communities".

The Plenary Council can make decisions which are specific to Australia (subject to final approval in Rome).

It can also make submissions to Rome on matters that affect the Universal Church, such as priestly celibacy and the diaconate of women. At this stage only Bishops have what is called a deliberative vote. Laity have a consultative vote only.

However there are moves to give the laity full voting rights, in the spirit of church reform, and these may be discussed when the Australian Bishops all go to Rome this June to meet the Pope and with him address the state of the Australian Church.

The Pope has made clear that all Catholics, through Baptism, share Christ's priestly office.

Clericalism, the belief that those in clerical office were superior Catholics, is no more.

The full ramifications of this are yet not clear. They will however become a lot clearer at The 2021 Plenary Council.

Listen to what the Spirit is saying to the Churches.
