Plenary Council 2020.

New Bishop calls for renewal of the Church through the Plenary Council 2020.

Last Monday 4 November our new Bishop Anthony Randazzo was installed. He chose to be installed on the feast of St Charles Borromeo, one of the great reformers of the Church when the church was facing the challenge of the Protestant Reformation. Bishop Randazzo is a member of the Bishop's commission oversighting the Plenary Council. Set out below is an extract of a lecture he gave in August 2018 about his vision for the Plenary Council.

The Plenary Council should not be an opportunity to indulge in self-fulfilment and self-centred desires about what the Catholic faith should be. It can be tempting to turn the Council into a long shopping list of what I want the faith to be for me, he said.

Instead it should be about encountering the person of Jesus Christ, and bringing that encounter to others. He warned that reducing the outcomes of the Council to a program while tempting, miss the fact that ultimately the church is not a program.

If we come up as just a program then we've missed a valuable opportunity to do something more radical... We need to keep constantly in mind that the root of our faith is a person – Jesus Christ

Self-fulfilment, or feeling good in yourself, will not address the many challenges facing the Church in Australia today. Nor will it give us the freedom and communion we seek.

If there is a program that I want to see reflected in the Plenary Council it is the building of the desire for the person of Christ and a desire to stay in communion with the Church by following Christ constantly, he said. My hope is that the council will be a true ecclesial encounter that will spark the desire for Christ... So that all may come to see the transformative gaze the face of Christ. In his sermon the Bishop emphasise's the role of St Charles as a reformer. He acknowledged the Saint is "best remembered as a bold reformer of the Church which had become corrupted." He continued: "at the heart of Charles preaching was a call to conversion which would lead to renewal, and lay the foundation of authentic reform. Reform was only possible in the church when it was preceded by personal and genuine conversion and renewal."
