Changing Mass Times

Since 2022 the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) has been discussing a proposal to decrease the number of Sunday morning Masses from three to two. Bishop Randazzo has now given us permission to make the change.

Vigil Mass at 5pm on Saturday will remain unchanged because a good children's ministry is developing around this Mass; its numbers have remained high; and this time is less taxing for one priest.

The proposed new Sunday Mass times are 7.30am and 9.30am.

At their meeting 1 February the PPC discussed various combinations of Mass times, and the advantages and disadvantages of each, but ultimately decided that fairest way to move forward, with the least disruption to the parish, is to consolidate the starting times of Masses. So instead of extending these times over three hours as in the past (from 7am to 10am) we will now extend the start times over two hours (from 7.30am to 9.30am).

Parishioner concerns

This announcement was made at all Masses last weekend and parishioner feedback has been sought. Overwhelmingly the response was in support of some change and most see these as appropriate times. The most common objection was from the choir that 9.30am is too late. Some parishioners also felt we did not need a change.

What is next?

The proposed new times of 7.30am and 9.30am will be forwarded to the Bishop for his approval. When we have this, we will set a date for the changeover and the new times will be well advertised in the parish before any change happens.

Is the change permanent?

The presumption is yes, but there will be a review after six months to consider the impact of the change in Mass times on the parish.

Lenten Penance 2024

“The Season of Lent is a most important time of preparation for the celebration of Easter we are drawn more deeply into the mystery of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

The Season of Lent commences on Ash Wednesday Marking our foreheads with ashes in the sign of the cross on Ash Wednesday is an outward sign of internal conversion. It is also an invitation to “Turn away from sin and believe the good news” we acknowledge our human vulnerability, and we pray to be strengthened by God's grace, mercy, and love.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, abstinence from meat is to be observed by those who have completed their fourteenth year of age. Those who are aged between 18 and 60 are to fast on these days.

On all other Fridays of Lent the law of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by prayer, self-denial or helping others.

Each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This is done between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday (26th May). All the faithful are obliged to confess their grave sins at least once a year.”
