

Catholic schools under attack a message from the PPC

Many parishioners may not be aware that a recent report by the Australian Law Reform Commission (the commission) to the federal government, if implemented, would have a devastating impact on Catholic schools and indeed on all religious schools.

The federal government is currently receiving submissions in respect of the future of religious schools. This is part of the general enquiry into discrimination / religion / LGBTI.

The commission report has been strongly opposed by the Catholic bishops as well as by the Protestant churches and the Islamic Council. It proposes that religious schools only be allowed to require religious belief or involvement from teachers whose jobs are actually religious. This means in Catholic schools that only the religious education teacher would have to be Catholic. All other staff, be they the principal, teachers or office staff, could be of any religion or of no religion. At present in Catholic schools' teachers are not necessarily required to be Catholic but they must all agree to uphold what is called the "Catholic ethos".

Catholic values should permeate the school and the Catholic faith upheld, propagated and defended. But this would not be possible under the commission's proposed system as religion would simply become a subject just as it is in state schools with Scripture teachers. Over a period of time – in this modern age probably only a short time – Catholic schools would become more secular and only nominally Catholic. As one commentator put it, they would be" like state schools with a crucifix."

We are asked to get involved in the defence of Catholic education. The PPC will be writing on behalf of the parish to both our new federal member, Dr Reid, and the Prime Minister, Mr Albanese. It is important that the whole parish be involved in the defence of Catholic schools and it may be necessary to ask parishioners to write individual letters or join a delegation to the federal member.

The Catholic education system in Australia has been achieved through the enormous sacrifice of thousands of religious, both nuns and brothers and now lay teachers, and by the financial commitment of hundreds of thousands of Catholics. While it now receives federal assistance it owes its creation to the determination of Catholics to defend their faith in what was originally in Australia a hostile Protestant society and which is now a hostile secular society. Tragically this will probably not be the last time Catholic education is under attack just as the Catholic Church itself is under constant attack.
