Saint of the Week

St Anthony Feast Day 13 June

St Anthony of Padua or Anthony of Lisbon was a Portuguese Catholic priest and friar of the

Franciscan Order. He was born and raised by a wealthy family in Lisbon, Portugal, and died in Padua, Italy.

As a Doctor of the Church, he is the only one with the title, **Evangelical Doctor**. His knowledge of the Scriptures also resulted in him being known as the "Ark of the Testament." St. Anthony left the Church a legacy of Sermons, for Sundays, for Marian Days and for Festivals.

He is especially invoked and venerated all over the world as the patron saint for the **recovery of lost items** and is credited with many miracles involving lost people, lost things and even lost spiritual goods and faith.


