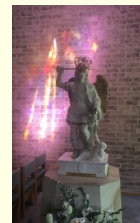

Community News: The Australian Childhood Foundation have released a free [Practice Guide: Understanding Compassion, Fatigue, Vicarious Trauma and Burnout](#). Effective therapeutic care is situated within a relationship-based approach to practice. Thus, the health and wellbeing of staff involved in this work is central to their ability to engage in relationships of care that have a therapeutic intent. This guide provides staff and managers with information about secondary traumatic stress, vicarious trauma, compassion fatigue and burnout. It describes organisational, client-related and personal risk and protective factors and provides strategies for assessing and addressing staff support and well-being.

Learning Hub: TAFE NSW are welcoming Expressions of Interest for a short course on Trauma Informed Practice. This is a great opportunity to develop skills in this area and is particularly useful if you are working or studying in the fields of ageing, disability, allied health, mental health, counselling, pastoral support or community services. 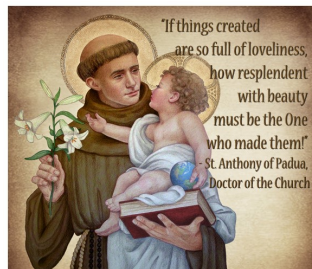
The answer to that question will no doubt occupy a considerable amount of discussion when we discuss the book on the Friday 24th June 1600 in the parish offices.

Saint of the Week

St Anthony Feast Day 13 June



St Anthony of Padua or Anthony of Lisbon was a Portuguese Catholic priest and friar of the Franciscan Order. He was born and raised by a wealthy family in Lisbon, Portugal, and died in Padua, Italy.

As a Doctor of the Church, he is the only one with the title, **Evangelical Doctor**. His knowledge of the Scriptures also resulted in him being known as the "Ark of the Testament." St. Anthony left the Church a legacy of Sermons, for Sundays, for Marian Days and for Festivals.

He is especially invoked and venerated all over the world as the patron saint for the **recovery of lost items** and is credited with many miracles involving lost people, lost things and even lost spiritual goods and faith.

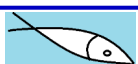
