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Safeguarding Our Children and Our Shrine

The Parish Pastoral Council has carefully considered the condition of the trees located at the front and rear of the shrine. These trees are exotic species rather than native Australian trees. Their root systems are gradually lifting the surrounding tiles and, over time, could compromise the integrity of the shrine. In addition, there is an ongoing risk of falling branches in an area regularly used by school children.

Many will remember the tragic death of a child in 2024 following the unexpected failure of a tree branch at a state school. While we have no indication of an immediate danger here, the Parish believes it is important to act responsibly to ensure the safety of our children and to protect this cherished place of prayer.

You may have noticed that the rear trees have left marks on the shrine wall over time. The wall will be cleaned. For these reasons, the Parish Pastoral Council has determined that the trees should be removed during the upcoming school holidays. In their place, we will plant attractive flowering shrubs and native plants to enhance the beauty of the shrine while creating a safer environment for everyone.

Thank you for your understanding and continued support as we care for both our parish community and this special place of devotion.

Bookclub

The book for July is Chesterton's **A Man Who Was Thursday**. He very often reads as epigrams strung together by deep insights and childlike wonder. "Because children have abounding vitality, because they are in spirit, fierce and free, therefore they want things repeated and unchanged. They always say, "Do it again"; and the grown-up person does it again, until he's nearly dead. For grown-up people are not strong enough to exult in monotony. But perhaps God is strong enough to exult in monotony. It is possible that God says every morning, "Do it again" to the sun; and every evening, "Do it again" to the moon. It may not be automatic necessity that makes all daisies alike; it may be that God makes every daisy separately but has never got tired of making them. It may be that He has the eternal appetite of infancy; for we have sinned and grown old, and our Father is younger than we. The repetition in Nature may not be a mere recurrence; it may be a theatrical encore." Reading Chesterton can be a bit like a child saying "Do it again."

In August our book club will be reading C S Lewis autobiography **Surprised by Joy** and in September we will read Pope Leo's first encyclical **Magnifica Humanitas**.

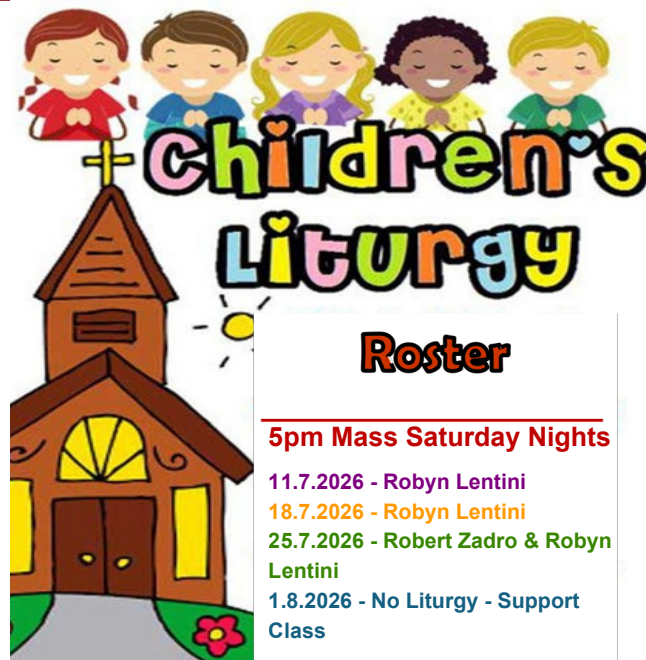
What is spiritual direction?

In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence. A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.
