## New School Buildings

Last week three demountables were moved to their new, temporary position on the oval. Next Tuesday or Wednesday one more demountable will be moved off site and the area that was under the demountables will be cleaned up and fenced off. Next week the services will be re-connected to the five demountables left on site for the teachers to return on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> January to begin preparations for the 2024 school year.

The building of seven new classrooms will begin in March 2024. These rooms will be built in the space between the play equipment and the upper two demountables. It will be a raised building so there will be enough space for a full school assemble under the building.

In spiritual direction you reflect deeply on the experiences of your daily life, your loves, hurts, dreams, joys and fears.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.

Spiritual direction is really not about being directed, nor is it therapy, or counselling. Rather, it is very much about being encouraged to draw closer to God whether that be in your prayer life, relationships, in nature, or in the events of your life. The privilege and responsibility of a spiritual director is to journey with you, in one-on-one conversations, as you deepen your relationship with God. What is shared is held in confidence.

A meeting time is agreed upon, usually once a month, for an hour.
