Giving in the Parish

We have **two regular collections** in the parish each weekend.

The First Collection goes to a common fund (**Pastoral Revenue**) across all diocesan parishes and is used to support the Bishop and all the priests (active and retired) in the Diocese. Donations for Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals and Easter and Christmas offerings also go to the Pastoral Revenue.

The Second Collection (**Church Account**) stays in the parish to meet all our expenses. Rents, planned giving, regular direct debits and other donations (unless explicitly directed elsewhere) go to the Church Account. Funds from the account built, and is now used to maintain the church, hall, offices, presbytery and grounds. It pays for all our running costs including insurance, employment and office, church and pastoral expenses. Donations through *Tap 'n' Go* in the church and *Donate Now* on our website go to the Church Account.

All other **special collections** go to the charity or activity that is advertised when we have the appeal.

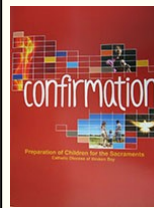

CONFIRMATION 2024



The Sacrament of Confirmation is offered to baptised children in Year 3 and older. Confirmation is usually the next Sacrament after Baptism, and before Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

Children receiving Confirmation will be presented to the Parish at all the Masses over this weekend. Mass times are Saturday 18th May at 5.00pm, or Sunday 19th May at 7.30am and 9.30am

STEP 5: CONFIRMATION DAY

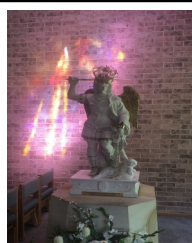

Mass in our Parish 9am to pray for those who gave their lives in service and for those who fought to give us peace.

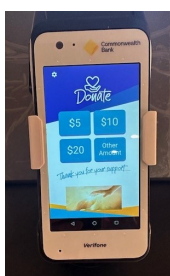
Mass will be followed by tea and coffee and Anzac biscuits.

Book Club

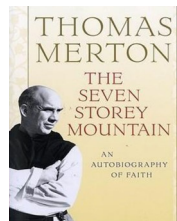
The next book club meeting will take place on 26th May at 1600 hrs in the parish offices.

We will be discussing Thomas Merton's **The Seven Story Mountain**. Evelyn Waugh had a lot to say about Merton's skill as a writer but of this particular book he wrote that "it may well prove to be of permanent interest in the history of religious experience." Graham Greene called it "an autobiography with a pattern and meaning for us all." Clare Boothe Luce predicted, "it is to a book like this that man will turn one hundred years from now to find out what went on in the heart of man in this cruel century." It is the twentieth century bookend to Theresa of Avila and John of the Cross.

In May we will be reading **Born Bad** by James Boyce and in June we will be reading Jacques Phillipa's book on prayer called **Time for God**.

It talks of four types of dignity - ontological, moral, social and existential – and notes that "there is an ever-growing risk of reducing human dignity" and identifies thirteen "grave violations".
