The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Memorial of the Most Immaculate Heart of Mary, are both celebrated this month.

While worship is directed to the person of Jesus Christ, His heart functions as a symbol of his love.

In 2025, Pope Leo XIV said to speak of the Sacred Heart was to: “reflect on the entire mystery of the Lord’s incarnation, death and resurrection, which is entrusted in a special way to us, so that we can make it present in our world.”

Similarly, Saint John Paul II said the devotion to the Most Immaculate Heart of Mary draws inspiration from Scripture and is a symbol of her love of God, Jesus her Son and all those under her care.

“It can be said that our devotion to Mary’s Immaculate Heart expresses our reverence for her maternal compassion both for Jesus and for all of her spiritual children, as she stood at the foot of the Cross,” he said.

When the Most Immaculate Heart of Mary was first instituted as a feast, it was celebrated on 22 August to coincide with the traditional octave day of the Assumption.

In 1969, it was moved by Pope Paul VI to the Saturday immediately following the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which takes place the day before this year.

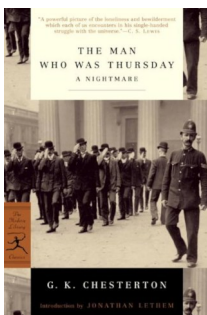
For Saint John Paul II, the two devotions were deeply connected: “These devotions seek to direct our attention to Christ and to the role of his Mother in the mystery of Redemption, and, though distinct, they are interrelated by reason of the enduring relation of love that exists between the Son and his Mother.”

## Bookclub

In June our book club will be reading Stephen F Auth's book "Pilgrimage to the Museum-Man's Search for God Through Art and Time" In this book, Auth takes us on a journey that is both artistic and spiritual. It is essentially a guided tour through New York's Metropolitan Museum that reminds us that through every age, artists have been inspired through beauty that hints at a search for God. It is a book filled with colourful images, one for the pool room.



In July we will be discussing one of Chesterton's most loved books: "The Man Who Was Thursday- a Nightmare". A metaphysical thriller that involves seven anarchists in turn of the century London who are represented by days of the week. A critique of moral relativism and nihilism.



In August we will be returning to C S Lewis to read his autobiography and his conversion story "Surprised by Joy". This book has been hugely influential.

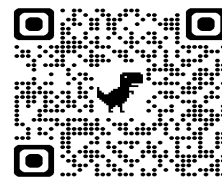
