In October we will be reading Song at the **Scaffold** by Gertrude von Le Fort. Set during the French Revolution, when madness was thick in the air, this short novel is based on a true story of the Carmelite nuns of Compiègne, who offered their lives for the preservation of the Church in France.

The universal symbol of the Christian faith, the cross represents Jesus Christ's victory over death and source of eternal salvation.

In the Eastern Churches the feast dates back to the dedication of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the site of Christ's tomb, in Jerusalem around 335 AD.

It was adopted by the Roman Catholic Church in the 7th century. This redemptive transformation of a barbaric instrument of torture into a divine symbol of hope for mankind represents the universal nature of Christ's sacrifice.

The Exaltation of the Holy Cross also commemorates the discovery of the True Cross, of Calvary, and the tomb of Christ by St Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine.

This day is a special reminder that crosses in life should not be avoided but transformed. Although the suffering may remain, it must be redeemed suffering, and so bearing an abundance of good fruit in ways that only God can accomplish.




