


## The Season of Lent

is a time of preparation for the celebration of Easter.

Lent commences on **Ash Wednesday** when our foreheads are marked with ashes in the sign of the cross as an outward sign of internal conversion.

On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday **abstinence from meat** is to be observed by those who have completed their fourteenth year of age. Those who are aged between 18 and 60 are also required to **fast** on these days. To "fast" means eating two small meals and one normal meal, and nothing else during the day.

On all other **Fridays in Lent** the law of the common practice of penance is fulfilled by an act of prayer, self-denial or helping others. Between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday (at the end of Easter) all the faithful are obliged to receive **Holy Communion** and to **confess** any grave sins.



This is the final week of our First Fruits initiative, but it continues as an ongoing invitation to deepen our commitment to the mission of our parish through intentional planned giving. Resources are available in the pamphlet rack at the back of the church.

*What are some things a grandparent can do to raise their grandchildren in the faith?*


- # Teach your children how to pray.

At the end of February our book club will be discussing Rabbi Jonathon Sacks' book **A Letter in the Scroll**. Every Jew is a letter, he writes, and when letters are joined to others they make words. Words together make sentences. Sentences make paragraphs, and paragraphs join to make a story. So every Jew is part of a story constructed over time for which the Torah scroll bears witness. This book seeks to answer the question: What does it mean to be a part of this story, and "why am I a Jew" The answer is relevant to anyone interested in exploring their relationship with God. Jonathan Sacks is a splendid writer. He has written extensively as a theologian and philosopher with a profound understanding of human nature. I have not read one of his books that I haven't enjoyed thoroughly.

In March we will read Tolstoy's **A Confession**, a book he wrote in his early fifties. Thankfully it is not nearly as long as his other writings.
