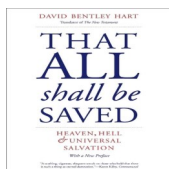
Bookclub

Universalism (the idea that all people, everywhere and throughout all time, are saved through Jesus Christ) has a long history. It is not surprising really, given the idea that an eternal hell is a fairly sobering thought, and many throughout the ages have argued one way or the other. In recent years, the response to Bishop Barron expressing a “hope” that universalism might be true suggests that the idea of universalism has not gone away. Our book club at 4pm on June 27th will be discussing a book by David Bentley Hart **That All Shall be Saved** which is part of this long history of debate. Join us if this might interest you.

In July we will be reading Brant Pitre’s book **Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist**.

In August we will read Shusaku Endo’s 1993 novel **Deep River** about four Japanese tourists on a pilgrimage to the Ganges in India in search of spiritual discoveries. Many may be more familiar with his book “Silence” which has been made into a film by Martin Scorsese.

Gradually, as you contemplate, you may begin to discover how God's spirit is moving in your life and that God has been waiting for you to see this closer relationship.


