Abortion Legislation.

The bill to effectively allow abortion on demand in NSW comes before the upper house of parliament again this week. It passed its 2nd Reading 4 weeks ago and was then adjourned so that a committee could look at the legislation and make recommendations for amendment. The committee, representing all parties, has now, by majority, made no less than 10 recommendations for changes.

Though only one week was allowed for submissions no less than 14,000 poured in. MPs reported a flood of letters and emails running 4:1 against the legislation, including many from this parish. In addition a petition signed by 237 members of this parish was tabled in the Legislative Council, the state upper house.

The main recommendations for amendment are:

- 1. Abortion only to be allowed after 20 weeks to save the life of the mother or another unborn child.
- 2. Prohibit abortions made for sex selection.
- 3. Save the baby that is born alive after a failed abortion.
- 4. Offer counselling services to women seeking an abortion.
- 5. Allow doctors and nurses the rights of conscientious objection.

It is not clear whether the amendments will be made. Our own Central Coast based member, Taylor Martin, has strongly oppose the legislation and will support the amendments.

This legislation is a test for every Member of Parliament and indeed every voter about their commitment to human life and human dignity.

Everyone is urged to pray that unborn children will be protected.

All members of the parish who sent emails, wrote letters and signed the petition are to be commended for their commitment to Christian teaching on the sanctity of human life.

Plenary Council 2020. The parish is now asked to enter a new phase of preparation for the plenary Council to be held in 2020 in Adelaide. 222,000 submissions were received and the main points need to be discussed and determined at a parish level. A program for further involvement of the parish is to be presented and discussed by the parish council this month. Again everyone is asked to pray that the Holy Spirit will guide the Catholic Church in Australia through its present difficulties into a brighter future.
